## CHAPLAINCY IN AN AGE OF ECOLOGICAL CRISIS

*Recent news about the health and future of our Planet presents a dim message. The environmental challenges we face as a global family are daunting. Though there are signs and examples of positive change, the scientific evidence affirms the possibility that we are entering into an era known as the Sixth Great Extinction.*

## ***Spiritual Direction Workgroup to Meet at the Gathering***

At our 2016 Gathering, a workgroup was formed to explore the topic of Spiritual Direction. Part of the original vision for CSCPF was to be a community of not only qualified clinical chaplains, but also persons who embody spiritual commitment and integration from diverse spiritual perspectives. The inclusion of the words “and Pastoral Formation” in our name reflects this commitment.

Affirming the importance of personal growth within the practice of spiritual caregiving, the Spiritual Direction workgroup discussed orienting ideas and values that enrich CSCPF members’ capacities for companionship others in the depths of their spiritual journeys.

Three general areas for approaching spiritual growth were identified: **Formation, Skills** and **Discernment**.

**Formation** is the conscious awareness of, and effort to, integrate skills, learning, experience, insights and spiritual practice in our interior life. **Skills** include learning from external resources like books, seminars, tips from peers, and faith and moral development models. **Discernment** is what we do in examining how new insights from a source greater than ourselves can refine our ability to actively welcome Sacred Wisdom’s guidance.


